As schools nationally begin to reopen, all Trust schools will continue to follow DfE statutory guidance and associated Trust policies. This Trust remains committed to ensuring that in relation to the health and safety measures required due to COVID19 premises are safe for students, employees, visitors or members of the public.

Each Trust School has developed a Behaviour Policy addendum in line with COVID19 pandemic guidance, and is to be read alongside their existing Behaviour Policy. Each addendum is designed with the specific setting and context of each individual school taken into account and will detail aspects of school life that will experience changes as a result of COVID19 including:

- Arrivals, Departures and Moving Around School
- Handwashing and Hygiene
- Social Distancing
- Break and Lunch times
- Rewards and Sanctions
- Expectations of Students
- Positive Handling and Restraint
